Dare to be... extraordinary

An intriguing sculpture takes pride of place: a 6,3Kg meteorite that landed at Campo Del Cielo in Argentina about 4,000 years ago. It was described in 1576 by the Spanish Conquistadors.

The brass mechanism allows us to take control of this stone which crossed the universe, and to make it fly again.

This rare meteorite is one of the 6% of iron meteorites that fall to earth.

It is composed of Kamacite: an iron and nickel alloy that does not exist on Earth.

An alloy that we do not know how to reproduce and that was formed at the edge of our universe several billion years ago.
