The Unique & Eclectic Signature area of the M & O exhibition welcomes 9 creators who will propose unique creations. You will find them in Hall 5A Stand M53:

[Nathanaëlle Lobjoy](#) is a Parisian sculpter, she molds and draws since forever. She is specialized in the creation of screens and lights with poetic drawings, suspensions...

[Nicolas Giraud](#) creates furniture, lighting and objects from his studio in Normandy. He is inspired by materials such as wood, metal, plaster or concrete. Its wall lights reveal the veins of the wood with golden or silvery reflections.

[O Fil des Rêveries de nana](#) gives life to dreams by creating "filorêves": floral murals combining aluminum threads, cottons or kraft threads. All her creations are mounted on a metal support.

[Sophie Lalance](#) is a ceramist. Her travels in Japan inspire her in her creations: she is fascinated by the play of imprints applied by hand on raw soils such as white sandstone, black sandstone

[Les Alsaciens de Paris](#) are Parisian designers and manufacturers. They create decorative animals made with plexiglass or wood with contemporary lines.

[Au Fil de la Matière](#) created lights inspired by mosaic and Tiffany stained glass techniques. It mixes the work of concrete, wood and colors creating unique atmospheres with materials such as glass, tin solder, bamboo.

[Juliette Desrumaux](#) works with linen in the respect of ecology. Her personalized tea towels come to life in black and white printed under names such as "The Sea Wolf", "The Bather," The Shrimp Fisherman "...

[Agnès Bourayne](#) shapes recycled kraft paper and offers lights in soft, warm colors. The inner and outer parts show the work of the collage of lozenges that are painted, cut and glued pieces by pieces.

[Nadia Freyer](#) is inspired by digital art, street art and comics in the creation of her "pop" color cushions. She has forged a strong partnership in her achievements with the British artist Adrian Pickett.
