HEYMAT NOMINATED FOR TWO PRESTIGIOUS DESIGN AWARDS



Norwegian mat company Heymat, founded in 2015, has been nominated for two global design awards in 2019. Heymat had already been nominated for NYCxDesign in the "Residential Flooring" category, and now it's confirmed that they have also been nominated for the German Design Awards 2020. Both nominations are for *Heymat+, a* collection of hall mats designed by Oslo-based designer Kristine Five Melvær.

Heymat's design philosophy involves creating mats for the home that are identical in quality to industrial mats. The brand was founded in Mo i Rana, close to the Arctic Circle in northern Norway, and is still based there. The region is often subject to rough weather, and this is what led founders Sonja Djønne and Thoralf Lian to create a functional and hardwearing mat for entrance halls, which at the same time boasts a strong design element. In addition to functionality and design, Heymat are also passionate about sustainability. The collection that has been nominated, *Heymat+*, has a pile manufactured from 100 per cent recycled plastic and is backed with hard-wearing nitrile rubber.



The fact that Heymat, a brand that has only been in existence for four years, has already garnered two such prestigious nominations is naturally a source of great pride.

"The Intention behind *Heymat*+ is to show that it is possible to produce a sustainable product without having to sacrifice function or aesthetics The NYCxDesign Awards provide an exceptional opportunity to create awareness about both our product and our ambition to contribute to a more nature-friendly design sector," says Sonja Djønne, CEO of Heymat.

The *Heymat*+ collection has been designed by Norwegian designer Kristine Five Melvær. Just like Heymat, she believes that you don't need to compromise when it comes to design and function. *Heymat*+ comprises the mats *Sand*, *Sjø* and *Strå*, designed with nature as inspiration, and this is reflected in the three-dimensional design and the choice of colours and product names.
