Each basket is signed by the artisan who has made it. By purchasing a Kiondo basket you become an essential part of this story.

Mifuko's KIONDO basket is a good example of Finnish design and Kenyan craftmanship. KIONDOs (that is how Mifuko's baskets are called) solve the problem of storage of various objects and also the problem of disposable plastic shopping bags. Baskets are used for storage, grocery shopping or plant sitting. The colors of the products vary – from colorful to nature infused ones.

Mifuko supports circular economy, sustainability and women's empowerment. That is why Mifuko picks materials taking recycling and upcycling into consideration. The philosophy of Mifuko is to produce esthetical sustainable products and to empower women in the rural villages of Kenya by providing them with necessary skills and a job.
