From 2 September, to echo Paris Design Week, FUNDAMENTAL will be coming to THE CENTRE POMPIDOU SHOP with a brand new, colourful display based on a unique installation designed especially for the space. The shop's main window will be dedicated to their brand-new design, the GRAVITY tray, made from coloured stainless steel and on sale exclusively at THE CENTRE POMPIDOU SHOP, in a limited and numbered special edition.

This display will also feature a wider range of design objects that evoke the theme of "Regeneration: recycling/ecology, upcycling, customisation, etc.", including the "Plissés" BY SONSON TINGAUD, the Remember Me collection produced by HORM CASAMANIA, book covers by MARON BOUILLIE, ECTOR sneakers, designs by PARIBORDOBIARRITZ, PILOT PINTOR, the innovative marker, and the YOMI armchair by MOJOW DESIGN.

Eco-friendly - Aware of the challenges to our environment, MARON BOUILLIE uses environmentally-friendly materials. The products are printed onto recycled polyester (plastic bottles) and lined with organic cotton. Packaging is kept to a minimum, using only paper and card.
