

# VICTORIA MAGNIANT TAKES PART IN PARIS DESIGN WEEK 2020



Victoria is a celebrated multidisciplinary designer based in Paris who graduated from Central Saint Martin's School of Art & Design in 2002. In 2015, she was granted simultaneously «le prix découverte» Maison et Objet and «le label VIA», two coveted French design awards. In 2017 she opened Galerie V in Paris. Token of her personal engagement in social and ecological issues, her research explores the bridges between traditional manufacturing and innovative technologies. She is well-known for attentively pondering culture, craftsmanship and ethics before determining which materials she will use for her creations.

In September 2020 Victoria Magniant is presenting a new collection **Back To Earth**, in a attempt to bring the comforting beauty cosmic and meteorological phenomenon in our home.

She chose to work with typical french organic stone, the blue stone of Savoie, from the french Alpes to bring a sens of outdoor sensuality to our intimate space with the Satellite tables.

She is also presenting patinated brass sconces, to recall the mesmerizing effect of a lunar eclipse in the sky, playing around simple sculptural shapes to capture interesting lighting effects.

This year for the first time, she develloped a collection of photophores and vases with joyfull shapes and a strong contrast between the glass and metal.

The Back to Earth collection is designed to bring a comforting presence whilst reconnecting us with our intimate spaces.
