

Fermob brings back Face à Face, the compact, contemporary writing desk born from its close collaborative relationship with designer Pascal Mourgue

"This piece was where it all began," says Fermob CEO Bernard Reybier. When Reybier decided to take over Fermob, at the time a modest-sized workshop, it had already released Face à Face – the timeless yet subversive writing desk designed by Pascal Mourgue. It was the product that clinched it for him. "It perfectly encapsulated the potential I saw in the material, and in the business," adds Reybier. "I'm delighted that we're re-releasing it today."

Back in the early 1980s, Fermob and Pascal Mourgue joined forces to put a new twist on this classic item of wooden furniture, bringing it bang up to date and on trend. Together, drawing on the designer's cabinet-making expertise and the manufacturer's metalwork know-how, they created a piece that truly stood out from the brand's other collections. Face à Face was an instant hit, scooping the Grand Prix de la Création award in 1985.

Almost 35 years on since it was first released, needs and tastes have evolved beyond recognition. That's why the 2019 version has been reworked to cater to modern lifestyles, with clever additions including USB and power sockets, practical and attractive trinket compartments, and a new, ultra-flat design that means Face à Face now sits flush against a wall.

Design is one of Fermob's top priorities. While most collections are designed for outdoor use, they are equally at home inside. So it comes as no surprise that the brand also makes statement pieces designed specifically for indoor use.
