

The fine ribbed pattern of the tray from the "Pulse" collection is created by applying ring structures to the still unfired porcelain with shellac. The remaining areas are then washed out by hand. The shellac layer glows during the firing process. What remains is a delicate white-in-white pattern that can also be felt by hand.


The glazes that cover the surfaces of the deep blue, black or olive coloured trays are also a Hering Berlin development, for which Stefanie Hering experimented for months with specialised craftsmen: they are poured by hand, run a little differently on each object and also accumulate on the porcelain surface in ever varying opaque and transparent layers.

Follow up: Illusion

The interplay of light and shadow is already the theme of Stefanie Hering's celebrated "Cielo" Collection: holes are made in the fragile porcelain with a drill and knife; through these holes the light draws patterns on the surfaces below. "Illusion" takes up this motif, but this time in the form of white "points of light" dancing across a background of an elegant, iridescent grey-green tone.

The hand-made "Illusion" objects are the perfect complement to the service elements of "Cielo", but can also be combined excellently with other Hering Berlin collections, for example with "Silent Brass", "Polite Gold" or "Velvet", according to the "Mix & Match" principle.



The pomegranate once promised fertility and the blessing of children on Chinese porcelain, which made the long journey to Europe on merchant ships in the 17th century. Western connoisseurs valued the fruit, which was usually painted in blue, more for its refined aesthetics. It also characterises the Hering Berlin-Collection Granat, on which the shape was drawn in cobalt, sometimes as a whole, sometimes fragmented. The charming puzzle game extends over a multitude of shape variations and can be complemented particularly well with other décors that play into the blue, such as Silent Iron or Blue Silent. As the decor is dishwasher- and microwave-safe, it can also be used in the catering trade without any problems.






