Inspired by the curved shapes of these dunes, Santiago Sevillano created a silhouette of the Saler modular sofa. Due to its design, this sofa allows multiple combinations of seats and invites you to relax as if it is a sunny day at the beach.

The upholstered part of the sofa rests on a wooden base inspired by boardwalks leading through the dunes to the seashore.



Hoya Chair
