**FLYING SKYLARK**  
(WG4446)

The Eurasian skylark is widespread across Europe. In looks, both the male and female are rather dull; greyish-brown streaked on top and breast with off-white bellies. But in flight, they are awe-inspiring, and the species is renowned for the male's acrobatic song flight that he displays to proclaim the pair's territory.



**PINK ROBIN**  
(WG4813)

The pink robin makes its home in the cool temperate forests of south-eastern Australia. The male has a white spot on his forehead, bright pink breast, grey wings, rump and back, while the female's plumage is grey-brown. They build their nest in the fork of a tree about five meters above the ground using moss, spider webs, feathers, and fur.



**COMMON  
YELLOWTHROAT** (WG4676)

The common yellowthroat is a small yellow-green North American songbird. Its nickname in the midwestern USA is yellow bandit due to the male's black eye mask. Common yellowthroats build their nests almost exclusively in low-growing wetlands. Feeding their young with insects is a task shared between the parents, catching them in tangled vegetation or in mid-air.
