

The Créateurs Design Awards Announces

The 2023 CDA Nominees

New York, NY, January 4, 2023 - After reviewing hundreds of submissions from 55 countries, the 300 members of the Créateurs Design Association have selected their nominees for the Créateurs Design Awards. Nominees will be invited to attend the black-tie award ceremony on January 21, 2023, at the Shangri-La in Paris. Formerly the residence of Prince Roland Bonaparte, the hotel has been decadently reimagined as a Parisian palace.

Winners will be announced live during the ceremony, alongside the presentation of the Andrée Putman Lifetime Achievement Award to iconic Japanese architect Tadao Ando, followed by a special presentation of the Le Prix Charlotte Perriand to visionary American architect Jeanne Gang. The award ceremony will also be streamed live on the <u>CDA website</u> at 7:00 pm (Paris Time, GMT+1).

Nominees and their guests will be invited to attend an exclusive after-party in Bonaparte's previous private residence, with live presentations from the chefs of the Shangri-La, while enjoying champagne from Ruinart and expansive views of the Eiffel Tower.
