They manufactured around two thousands Relax between 1963 and 1983 in the Basque Country. **Anne-Laure Détrie Gras**, the granddaughter of Roger Détrie wants to breathe new life into this innovative and authentic project. She then contacted **Coralie Frick and Arnaud Le Cat**, a duo of Parisian designers.

Coralie Frick, born in 1983 in Liechtenstein and **Arnaud Le Cat,** born in 1985 in Paris, invent and design functional and refined design pieces to accompany new lifestyles, light and moving.
