It has been a long journey in which we have had a great team of professionals supporting us and which we've complemented with our latest line dedicated to Order, 'Home in Order', comments Carolina Sánchez de Movellán, founder of Sol&Luna."

These products have turned the Spanish company into a leader in the expression of leathered art. In its eagerness to continue innovating, it has been working for years with a blend of materials such as recycled glass, ceramics, wicker, and palm, creating unique pieces for decoration of homes, offices spaces, and high-end hospitality.
