SRILANKA

This teapot is named after Srilanka, the leading producer of Ceylon tea in the world. You will probably like an interesting balance between the sharp iron handle and the solid body form.



BLOSSOM

This aesthetically shaped, Japanese pottery "Blossom" dishware resembles the chrysanthemum flower, the national flower and traditional motif of Japan. The radiating streaks like petals, elaborately hand-carved by our craftspeople, help to focus the eye on the food.

GLOBE

"Globe" has been designed to give an impression of "The earth is round." Its motif is a compelling vintage terrestrial globe.

Transferred in black and gray ink, the world map pattern looks very chic.









JUPITER

Pottery made from clay and minerals of earth is also a result of a beautiful chemical reaction. Glaze over rough red earthen disperses various size iron powder like a stardust to create a powerful and luring effect.
