The seed sachets are crafted from innovative paper produced using fibers from tomato processing waste, ensuring that no part of the plant goes to waste. These sachets are fully biodegradable and can be recycled with organic waste, making them as eco-friendly as the seeds they contain. #WordsAreSeeds

Additionally, the **Leporello**, a unique collector that holds multiple sachets to form a word or message, is another bundling option that adds even more value to the product. Made from paper derived from corn processing waste, the Leporello is completely customizable and offers an original, creative, and eco-friendly way to share meaningful messages with friends or colleagues

The graphic design for the Botanical Alphabet project has been expertly crafted by the Milan-based agency **The6th**, while the stunning photography featured in the project is credited to photographers **Mauro Turatti**, whose work beautifully captures the essence of each sachet, enhancing the overall appeal of the seed packets and celebrating the vibrant diversity of the botanical world.

Furthermore, we are proud to announce that the Botanical Alphabet has won second place at the **ADCI Awards 2024** in the Design - Packaging category, a prestigious recognition from the Italian Art Directors Club celebrating excellence in creative and design innovation.

In addition to the Botanical Alphabet, Piccolo offers a rich seed range through its **Original Series**, which includes a catalog of 90 Single Seed Packets and Seed Collections. These feature plant varieties specifically selected for urban gardeners, including balcony-friendly, pollinator-attractive, and edible plants. The thoughtfully crafted packaging not only contains essential growing tips but also offers culinary advice to inspire creativity in the kitchen, along with historical insights and interesting facts about each variety.

The collection resembles a mini-library, with packaging that is reminiscent of miniature books, or even posh chocolate bars, adding a touch of elegance to any gardening endeavor.
