We fuse natural materials with advanced technology to create poetic and contemplative design pieces. Alabaster, Estremoz marble, and other carefully selected stones, shaped by thousands of years of natural forces, serve as a canvas for modern technology. Through custom-designed electronics and carefully crafted algorithms, we transform these stones into objects that bridge the past and present, amplifying ancient wisdom with future possibilities.

Our signature piece, MOON, embodies this philosophy. More than an object, it reflects the ever-changing phases of the moon in real time, offering a quiet reminder of the things in life we cannot control and the beauty that lies in acceptance.

MOON Concept – More Than a Lamp, Light That Moves With the Moon

The only object in the world to accurately reflect the moon's phases in real time. As an autonomous light sculpture, it is crafted from the finest natural materials and has no on/off switch, illuminating only when the moon is visible at your location. It lights up automatically when the moon rises over the horizon and turns off when the moon sets—a quiet reminder of the beauty and power of forces greater than us.

The original MOON is crafted from the highest quality Alabaster, a natural stone with a moon-like landscape distinguished by its unique aguas and betas—the flowing waters and intricate veins that make each piece unmistakably one of a kind. Formed over millennia from gypsum minerals through the gradual evaporation of sulfate-rich waters, this alabaster embodies a timeless elegance shaped by nature itself. Due to its softness and fragility, alabaster demands meticulous craftsmanship. Our artisans exercise exceptional precision and care to preserve its delicate features and bring out its natural elegance.

Biography & Studio



Vadim A.F. Popowsky Founder and Creative Director

Vadim's journey into design began with a lifelong passion for creating and building. Growing up in an unfinished farmhouse in Schilde, he constantly transformed spaces, inspired by early memories like seeing a Gucci store etagère in Antwerp adorned with thousands of Tabasco bottles, where his mother briefly worked. This fascination with interiors and storytelling through objects shaped his creative vision.

After studying economics and years spent coding, Vadim found his way back to creation during the COVID-19 pandemic. While painting opened the door to artistic expression, he soon realized two dimensions couldn't fully capture his ideas. Vadim describes creation as "the essence of life," with MOON and other realizations serving as ways to express this philosophy.

The Studio in Lisbon operates primarily from Antwerp, where Vadim oversees the design, development, and commercialization of the studio's creations. From designing electronics, embedded software, and mobile applications to managing the full production process. Key collaborators, including architects and product designers Jean-Michel and Hiago from Marvilab, and freelance embedded systems specialist George Waller, bring essential expertise in architecture, product design, and electronics. Their contributions are crucial for material testing, prototyping, and ensuring that MOON meets high standards for quality and durability.

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
