Handcrafted in sustainably finished natural leather, it transforms an everyday container into a sculptural presence. Its measured geometry and soft curves embody a sense of functionality, where beauty arises from restraint.

The new piece will be available for pre-order starting November 13th, with public sales beginning November 19th. The launch reinforces MOR Design's commitment to creating pieces that combine timeless materials, artisanal craftsmanship, and architectural clarity.

Each SPOT Bowl is shaped by hand, using traditional leatherworking techniques that honors the individuality of the material. With time, its surface acquires a soft patina, deepening in tone and texture. What begins as a pure, minimal form evolves into something more personal, a reflection of care, presence, and daily ritual. The SPOT Bowl is not merely an accessory, but a study in balance and enduring beauty.
