The *horizon strips* redefine the relationship between the wall and the decor. Placed at mid-height, they become *a contemporary wainscoting;* placed as a high line, they extend the light and

emphasize perspective. In an old house or a minimalist space, they accompany the architecture without constraining it. Interiors gain in calm, rhythm, and silent elegance. "We wanted to invent a format that *invites freedom*, where everyone can create their own landscape," explains Anne Boghossian, founder of ANANBÔ. "These designs are no longer walls, but horizons to be composed."
