## H.ISLE IN THE CITY FROM 14 TO 19 JANUARY 2026

For thirty years, H.ISLE has been shaping in France a certain vision of light: precise, sculptural, architectural. Each fixture is born from a dialogue between hand and material, the result of mastered craftsmanship and a contemporary aesthetic. For the IN THE CITY 2026 parcours, the maison is taking over 10 rue du Four alongside Éditions Serge Mouille, from January 14 to 19, 2026, transforming the space into a luminous laboratory where textures, volumes, and intensities unfold. Within this ephemeral setting, H.ISLE unveils a new interpretation of its CARRÉ wall light, conceived here in an outdoor version with unprecedented proportions, enhanced by a delicately textured powder-coated finish.

## TWO KINDRED HOUSES: A MEANINGFUL PLACE

The meeting between H.ISLE and Éditions Serge Mouille feels like a natural fit, as their aesthetic languages resonate with one another: one contemporary and refined; the other timeless, deeply rooted in a design heritage that has become a reference. This connection also echoes Gaël Reyre's personal history. In the gallery once run by her grandparents, Serge Mouille's pieces already engaged in dialogue with a carefully curated selection of artworks and editions. A natural lineage, which continues today in this exhibition.

At 10 rue du Four, NOEMI, founded by Noémie Pauquet, presents itself as a curatorial space dedicated to a transversal vision of contemporary creation, where fashion, design, and sustainable craftsmanship meet and enrich one another. The choice of this address is no coincidence. Just a few steps from 145 boulevard Saint-Germain, where the Steph Simon Gallery—an iconic landmark of French design in the 1950s—60s—once stood. By establishing itself near this site of memory, H.ISLE positions itself within a deliberate editorial continuity, paying tribute to a creative lineage that spans generations.

"It's a nod to my grandparents," says Gaël Reyre, whose approach naturally follows the continuity of this heritage.


