With *Everyday Objects, Unexpected Season*, Letshelter presents a new way of looking at one of the most technical elements of the bathroom: the towel radiator. Designed for function and routine, it becomes a playful surface where color, irony and summer-inspired ceramic hooks find their place.

Handcrafted in Italy, Letshelter's ceramic hooks transform a simple daily gesture into a small visual and emotional disruption. Watermelons, stars and bold shapes introduce an unexpected season into a space traditionally governed by utility.

This project is not about decoration, but about perspective.

It suggests that even the most functional objects can carry personality, emotion and lightness — redefining the relationship between design and everyday life.
