

Barbara Munsel Unveils Handwoven Floral Textile at Maison & Objet

At Maison & Objet, artist Barbara Munsel presents new handwoven flower pieces that blurs the boundaries between textile, sculpture, and botanical study. Composed of delicately preserved flower petals woven into a transparent warp, the work reveals layers of color—soft blush, faded rose, pale gold—suspended in quiet tension.

Shown at Maison & Objet, it offers a poetic added value to the contemporary design landscape—inviting viewers to pause, look closely, and experience the intimacy of handwork at scale.
