

**RIPA: metal furniture Made in Italy at Maison&Objet**  
Paris, 15–19 January 2026



*Porto San Giorgio (FM, Italy), January 2026\_RIPA*, an **Italian brand** known for its expertise in **metal furniture** – essential in form, rigorous in design, and joyfully free in function – returns to **Maison&Objet from 15 to 19 January 2026**. Since 2011, it has worked at the intersection of craftsmanship and contemporary design, naturally embodying this edition's theme: *Past Reveals Future*.

Debuting in **Paris** is the year's first new release: **Pond**, a mirror by Tokyo-based designer **Nao Iwamatsu**. «The first time I used a camera – recalls Iwamatsu –. I captured the reflection in a puddle after the rain. It was so beautiful, even more captivating than the real landscape. **It felt like gazing into a pond—as if I were about to step in. That's the mirror I wanted to create**». Pond is a sculptural piece: a steel box, open on one side, with a circular or oval cut-out in the centre. Inside, fully mirrored surfaces create layered reflections and shifting visual depth, depending on the angle. The base becomes a small tray for everyday objects, gestures, and rituals. Like all RIPA creations, Pond balances function and imagination, with essential lines and timeless integrity. Available in various sizes and ten colourways.

Completing the display—set in a palette of matte pastels: Burro, Carta, Cielo, Seta, and Pesca—are key pieces from the RIPA catalogue: the **Coimbra lounge chair** and the **Chiodo series of tables and side tables**, now introduced in the new **STRATA** finish developed in collaboration with Colori Decora. A milestone in RIPA's material research, **STRATA** is the brand's first lime-based mineral coating, applied by hand to metal surfaces to create a tactile, stratified, organic texture. The colour, available in ten shades, becomes part of the material, enhancing its depth and variations without masking its nature.

**Chiodo** (design Roberto Cicchinè) is a collection of powder-coated metal furniture born from a “fixed idea”: to create a series of objects with the same form but different sizes and uses—for lovers of linear yet playful design, for those who embrace change, and for those who enjoy rearranging spaces with freedom.

Also designed by Roberto Cicchinè, **Coimbra** is a modular aluminium collection for indoor and outdoor use. Based on a module that merges a square with an arc, the collection includes armchairs, sofas, sideboards, consoles, totems, and storage units. Its retro inspiration, seen in the generous curves, is updated through thin metal profiles, clean lines, and versatile designs suited to residential, contract, or retail settings.

Chiodo and Coimbra will also feature in the **MOM Village** (Hall 6, Pad E94), the space curated by the MOM platform (Maison & Objet and More), in a 2026 selection themed in shades of blue.
