## ELEMENT&CO unveils Gemmes Garden, a capsule collection of sculptural furniture shaped by nature

Can a gemstone redefine the way we experience furniture?

Based in Madrid, ELEMENT&CO explores this question by transforming natural minerals into tangible, functional works of art. Specialising in bespoke furniture and personalised interior solutions, the studio creates entirely handcrafted pieces using noble, responsibly sourced materials. Its philosophy moves beyond trends, focusing instead on timeless design, material integrity and a deep respect for craftsmanship.

Led by Bryan Ou-Yang & Sasha Sanchez, ELEMENT&CO approaches furniture as a meeting point between art, craft and sustainable luxury. Each project unfolds as a narrative in which stone, metal and wood express their inherent character, inviting a slower, more contemplative engagement with design. At Maison&Objet Paris 2026, the studio presents Gemmes Garden: a capsule collection of collectible furniture that translates the raw beauty of gemstones into sculptural objects for contemporary interiors.

## GEMMES GARDEN COLLECTION

### Mineral matter as functional design

Gemmes Garden is born from a fascination with the intrinsic beauty of natural minerals and the ordered elegance of French gardens. The collection reinterprets gemstones as sculptural yet functional forms, where material, light and proportion exist in careful balance. Each piece reflects the dialogue between human intervention and nature's perfection, transforming raw mineral matter into enduring objects of design.

Comprising five distinctive pieces — Kiara, Niko, Gronda, Ocrub and Duophilia — the collection offers varied spatial experiences and emotional expressions. The natural qualities of each stone provide depth, texture and individuality, while the designs introduce a refined contemporary language that pairs mineral solidity with soft fabrics and hand-finished surfaces. Customisation options, from fabric selection to project-specific adaptations, ensure that every commission remains a unique creation.

Blurring the boundary between furniture and sculpture, Gemmes Garden positions each piece as both functional object and collectible design work. From bold statement pieces to versatile forms, the collection demonstrates how craftsmanship, material authenticity and thoughtful design can coexist in objects meant to be lived with, displayed and cherished.

Each piece is delivered with a certificate of authenticity, attesting to the natural origin of the gemstone, the artisanal processes involved and the singular characteristics of the work. This documentation reinforces the collection's status as collectible furniture, where value lies as much in material and process as in form.

## THE PIECES

### KIARA — Side Table

Hand-cut rose quartz shapes Kiara, revealing delicate silk-like veining and soft tonal variations. Its polished geometric form allows it to function as a side table, sculptural pedestal or design accent, bringing a sense of quiet luxury and contemplative presence to curated interiors.

### **NIKO — Side Table**

Defined by emerald fluorite, Niko expresses a bold yet refined character. Its cubic form, animated by the stone's internal patterns, creates a playful interaction with light and shadow, offering a dynamic presence within sophisticated spaces.

### **GRONDA — Side Table / Pouf**

Gronda combines hand-polished white quartz with a velvet-upholstered seat, balancing mineral solidity with tactile softness. Its low, rounded profile allows dual functionality as a pouf or side table, introducing versatility and calm into residential or hospitality settings.

### **OCRUB — Center / Coffee Table**

Carved from ochre jasper, Ocrub conveys warmth and depth through its layered mineral tones. The square center/coffee table features a subtle central recess for usability while preserving its sculptural clarity, anchoring a space with quiet strength.

### **DUOPHILIA — Bench / Center Table**

Duophilia is sculpted from petrified wood stone and offers dual functionality as a bench or center table. Its fluid, curved form explores balance and duality, while the mineralised texture adds visual richness. Designed to integrate naturally into interiors, terraces and landscaped environments alike.
