Steps onto the global stage at Maison&Objet Paris 2026

Showcasing new forces in Hong Kong industrial design

Organised by the Industrial Designers Society of Hong Kong (IDSHK) and sponsored by the Cultural and Creative Industries Development Agency (CCIDA) under the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, “**ReMIX · Yesterday's Future, Invent Tomorrow! Creative Business Partnership Programme**” (ReMIX) made its international debut at Maison&Objet Paris 2026, one of the world’s most influential international design fairs, from 15 to 19 January 2026 at the Paris Nord Villepinte Exhibition Centre in France.

In celebration of ReMIX’s first appearance at Maison&Objet Paris, the organisers will host The Grand Opening of the ReMIX Exhibition and Product Launch on 16 January. The ceremony will be officiated by Mr. Ball Cheung, President of IDSHK, with Ms. Drew Lai, Commissioner for Cultural and Creative Industries, serving as the Guest of Honour and delivering the opening address. Mr. Vincent Lhoste, CEO of Safi, Maison&Objet, will also attend in person to extend his congratulations to ReMIX, as well as to the participating Hong Kong brands and design teams. The opening ceremony not only marks ReMIX’s official entry onto the international stage, but also signifies the growing global presence of Hong Kong design—strengthened by government support and propelled by world-class platforms that enhance cross-border exchange and market connectivity.

Mr. Ball CHEUNG, President of IDSHK, said “ReMIX has always aimed to empower local brands through design, injecting fresh thinking into their development while opening up broader collaboration and growth opportunities for designers. Making our debut at Maison&Objet Paris, a top-tier international platform, is not only a strong recognition for the participating brands and design teams, it also underlines the competitiveness and unique voice of Hong Kong industrial design in the global market. We hope to take this opportunity to connect with buyers and industry professionals from around the world, fostering more cross-regional and cross-sector collaborations, and enabling Hong Kong brands and design to travel further and resonate more widely.”

Launched in 2021, “**ReMIX · Yesterday's Future, Invent Tomorrow!**” (ReMIX) has been fostering cross-disciplinary collaboration since its inception. By facilitating dynamic connections between visionary design professionals and premium brands from Hong Kong, the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, as well as Asian brands from across the continent, ReMIX continues to push the boundaries of possibility. The participating design teams bring a wealth of experience and perspectives, representing various fields including industrial design, fashion design,

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furniture design, architecture and illustration.

Advancing Hong Kong Design through Global Collaboration

At Maison&Objet Paris 2026, the ReMIX showcase will proudly present more than 90 collaborative products, encompassing cultural goods, eyewear, personal accessories, homeware, small furniture and toys. Visitors will be able to explore the results of partnerships between 20 brands and 17 visionary design teams, with over 50 newly launched collaborative products making their international debut in Paris. This presentation marks a significant milestone for ReMIX on the international stage, as Hong Kong design steps further into the global spotlight.

This powerful fusion of diverse disciplines ignites a synergistic exchange of fresh ideas, redefining the future through innovation and collaboration. Through this international platform, ReMIX illustrates the richness and relevance of Hong Kong design in today's global market, while reinforcing its role as a catalyst for cross-regional and cross-sector creative exchange.

In addition to leading a delegation of Hong Kong design talents to exhibit at Maison&Objet Paris 2026, ReMIX will organise a series of international exchange and professional visits for participating designers and brand representatives. These engagements seek to foster closer ties between Hong Kong's design community and leading design, cultural and educational institutions across Europe, further enhancing cross-cultural dialogue, professional collaboration, and global exposure for Hong Kong's creative industry.
