

From Paris to Copenhagen: Tivoli Presents Three Solid Wood Collections at 3 Days of Design

Ukraine's largest solid wood furniture manufacturer debuts at the Nordic festival with the Striha, ION, and Kars collections — 10–12 June at Ukraine House, Copenhagen

KYIV / COPENHAGEN — Tivoli, a returning Maison&Objet exhibitor and Ukraine's largest producer of solid wood seating and tables, is taking its collections north this June for its first participation at 3 Days of Design in Copenhagen.

From 10 to 12 June, Tivoli will present three collections at Ukraine House, Strandgade 27B — a space that brings together Ukrainian design talent on one of Europe's most respected design stages.

What's on Show

Striha and ION by designer Julia Kononenko are the collections Maison&Objet visitors will already know. Both are in solid hardwood throughout. Both have won eight international design awards between them in the past three years. In Copenhagen, they make their Nordic introduction.

The new addition is **Kars** — a complete furniture family developed in collaboration with Copenhagen-based Says Who Design Studio, launching publicly for the first time at 3 Days of Design.

Kars brings together Tivoli's Ukrainian craft tradition and Says Who's Scandinavian design sensibility across four pieces: the Brando Dining Chair, the Kars Dining Table, companion seating Brandy and Tone, and the Armchair Brando. Solid hardwood throughout. Designed for longevity. Nothing decorative, nothing wasted.

About Tivoli

Founded in Kyiv in 2014, Tivoli is a family-owned manufacturer of solid wood chairs and tables, now in its second generation of family leadership. The company employs 181 people, produces 15,000 pieces monthly, and exports to 26 countries across Europe, the Middle East, and beyond.

Since 2015, Tivoli has participated in 27 international exhibitions including four editions of Salone del Mobile and two editions of Maison&Objet. The brand powers its production using energy generated from wood waste.
