Fine Little Day Presents FW26

Since 2007, Fine Little Day has created space for artists' and illustrators' expressions in everyday life. In FW26, the stories unfold even further. Playful figures, folkloric references, embroidered landscapes, and graphic patterns come together in a collection that moves freely between art, textiles, and function.

When the Cat's Away, the Mice Will Play

In Freja Erixån's new collection, the well-known proverb comes to life in a visual universe of its own. Mice on adventures and cats that may be looking away—or only pretending to. The motifs appear on trays, coasters, an apron, a children's wool blanket, and an intricately embroidered cushion cover where balls of yarn, threads, and playful cats come together in a richly detailed narrative.

Grid

Fine Little Day presents new textiles by Evelina Kroon. Grid is a graphic pattern where colour and form create energy and movement. Woven in linen, the design is available as cushion covers, kitchen textiles, and fabric by the metre. A study in geometry where structure meets colour.

Keys – Wool Blanket

Keys by Victoria Eyrarn is a turquoise wool blanket featuring a graphic chain pattern that winds its way towards a cluster of keys. An expressive design in which everyday objects take on a decorative and storytelling quality.

Water Lilies – Wool Blanket

Water Lilies returns as a wool blanket in a new green colourway. Elisabeth Dunker's pattern of aquatic plants creates a calm, repeating landscape inspired by the rhythms of nature.

Dots – Embroidered Cushion Cover

One of Fine Little Day's most beloved patterns is now available in an embroidered version. Dots becomes a tactile surface where rhythm and structure create an expression that is both calm and present.

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Weeping birch – Embroidered Cushion Cover

Lisen Adbåge's Weeping birch is interpreted through rich embroidery on a heavy weight linen blend textile. Shades of yellow and brown highlight the weight and organic character of the trees.

Yoga – Embroidered Cushion Cover

Elisabeth Dunker's new activity-themed motif depicts bodies in motion, but in their own way. Combining embroidery and screen printing on unbleached linen, the design captures movement with humour and warmth.

Golfers – Embroidered Cushion Cover

The Golfers motif is presented in a new colourway. The embroidered figures are in the midst of play—free in both form and movement. A natural linen background gives the design a soft and timeless expression.

Holiday Collection – New Additions

This year's holiday collection is expanded with two new paper decorations. A Kurbits-inspired mobile, where folkloric forms float freely through the room, and a decorative garland with fir tree motifs designed to return year after year.

Skiers – Embroidered Table Runner

Elisabeth Dunker's skiers continue their journey through winter. The well-known motif is now presented as an embroidered table runner, where the figures bring movement across the table setting.

Rutig – Trays

Elisabeth Dunker's Rutig launches in new colour combinations. The graphic checks take on new life across trays in various sizes, creating a playful balance between order and spontaneity.
