From trim to texture. Inspired by vintage ribbons and trims, Appliqué combines the decorative dimension of ornamental needlework with the endurance and easy care of Chilewich textiles. Multiple weave structures come together to create a lively, tactile surface in two contemporary color palettes.

Pushing the boundaries of weaving. Tint explores the nature of color through geometric forms and color placement. A palette of only six hues—three as warp yarns and three as weft yarns—is expanded through multiple weave structures into a composition of nuanced colors.

Where materials meet. The beauty of Calacatta and Calacatta Gold marble meets the performance of easy-to-clean textiles in Marble. The Chilewich design team photographed marble slabs to capture the natural variations and tonal nuances of the Italian stone. These large-scaled compositions were then digitally printed onto a woven textile.

New neutrals. Foxtail is rooted in the quiet dynamism of diagonal lines. A closer look reveals yarns that incorporate multiple tones within each strand, creating a surface that is both harmonious and intriguing.



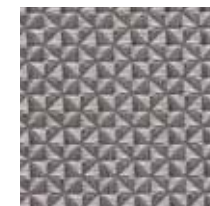

The art of the fold. Texture and pattern unite in Origami. By expanding the dimension of this crepe weave, our design team revealed its geometric elements, creating a multi-faceted surface in softly shimmering neutrals.

Flower power. Bring boldly scaled blooms to the table all year round with Mums, a bouquet-inspired debut that combines robust and easy-to-clean woven textiles with the vivid precision of digital printing.

Mums began with a visit to New York City's Union Square Greenmarket, where members of the Chilewich design team selected a colorful array of heirloom chrysanthemums. Back at the studio, individual blooms, including pom pom and spider mums, were photographed at close range to create floral portraits that complement one another but can also stand alone.

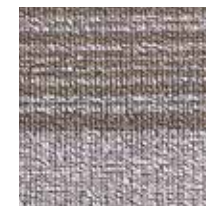
