Our new product Knotted Coat Rack will be presented during Paris Design Week as part of the Paris Design Week Factory show. Knotted Coat Rack is part of an Everyday Object series which is an ongoing series of contemporary functional objects designed by urkas and Studio Sadar.

ABOUT THE DESIGN

As architects and designers we are fascinated how often the layouts of our homes change as well as how often people move nowadays. Therefore we wanted to offer furniture that would reflect that. Compact, easy to use, easy to move around and fun.

Adjustable ceiling mounted coat rack is made using carefully designed 3D printed knots and rope. Minimalist but playful design with the vibrance of colour inspired by sailing knots. 3D printed knot is a "frozen" shape of the textile knot that works as a hanger for clothers and accessories. From a distance it looks like it is made of textile and when you come closer the texture is reveiled. So the object works as a surprise.

Knotted Coat Rack is a part of our MoDuLaR furniture collection - an ever-changing, modular furniture system that evokes creativity of the customer and increases awareness of beauty and the positive feeling of home. MoDuLaR is about joy, beauty, simplicity, better experience, and a sustainable approach to furnishing and living.

All materials and processes are environmentally responsible. Each product is hand assmbled using unique 3D printed components and Slovene fabric rope. Made in Slovenia. Available in a wide range of different colour combinations.

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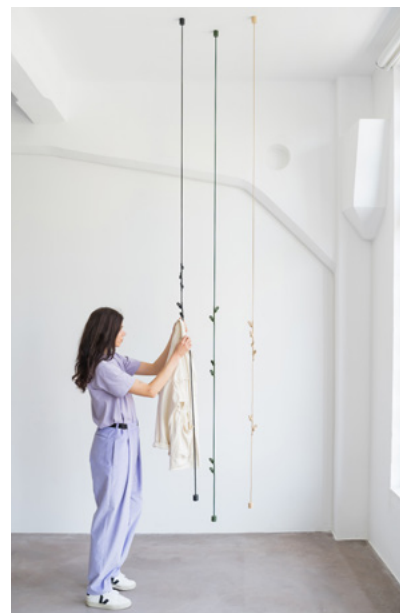
