## **Rinck at Paris Design Week 2025**

Ensemblier décorateur since 1841, Rinck designs exceptional interiors and collectible pieces, meticulously crafted in-house at its own millwork, joinery, and furniture workshops in France. The studio's creations are presented in its Parisian gallery in Saint-Germain-des-Prés and in its showroom at the New York Design Center.

For the upcoming Paris Design Week this September, and in celebration of the centenary of Art Deco, Rinck presents a curated selection of signature pieces that reflect a creative dialogue with its heritage. The collection offers a glimpse into the house's ongoing design thinking and creative process.

With 185 years of archives to draw from, Rinck stands at the intersection of diverse influences rooted in the history of the decorative arts. Art Deco, in particular, has played a key role in shaping Rinck's aesthetic and continues to inspire reinterpretations across generations.

Today, the house embraces a boldly contemporary spirit, with pieces and finishes born from cutting-edge research and development, all grounded in the finest French craftsmanship.
