

## UNFOLDING THE ADILO PENDANT LAMP FOR THE FIRST TIME IN FRANCE

Finnish lighting specialist Secto Design invites the press and design community to discover Adilo, its latest pendant lamp, debuting in France during Paris Design Week 2025. On view at the Secto Design showroom on the Champs-Élysées, the piece reflects the brand's ongoing evolution in form and function.

### An evolution in wooden lighting

Ingeniously engineered, Adilo is flat-packed for transport and storage, yet it unfolds into a sculptural centrepiece in one smooth gesture. Combining Finnish birch wood with remarkable spatial ingenuity, Adilo speaks to the brand's deep-rooted commitment to sustainability, craftsmanship, and innovation.

Designed by Finnish wood artisan and industrial designer Ilkka Kauppinen (b.1988), Adilo is the result of an extensive exploration into the spatial potential of ultra-thin plywood. A graduate of the LAB Institute of Design and Fine Arts, Kauppinen has a background in designing bespoke wooden furniture and saunas. His first luminaire, Adilo, also marks his first collaboration with Secto Design, a pioneer in wooden lighting design.

### Visit Secto Design in Paris

Following its earlier presentations in Milan and Copenhagen, the extensively design-protected Adilo prototype now makes its debut in the French design landscape as part of Paris Design Week.

The Secto Design showroom offers an inviting space to experience the novelty in person, alongside other notable designs from the brand's steadily growing collection. Highlights include the Kumulo pendant lamp, winner of both the iF Design Award 2025 and the Top of Design Award by Marie-Claire Maison, and the newly enhanced Owalo pendant, featuring updated technical details. As with all previous Secto Design luminaires, these pieces are the work of acclaimed architect and designer Seppo Koho (b.1967).

Each lamp is handmade at the company's factory in Heinola, Finland, using locally sourced, certified birch.
