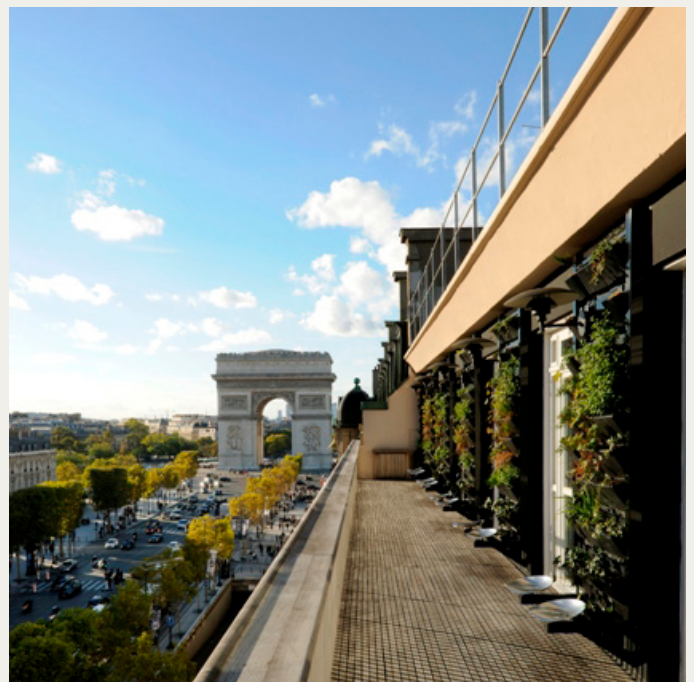


OUR HISTORY

For the Danish Design Showroom, she presents a limited-edition collection of rugs and wall hangings, featuring jacquard-woven tapestries and hand-knotted rugs crafted using the traditional Indo-Tibetan technique. The collection translates natural phenomena into contemporary textile works, where movement and tranquillity come together.
