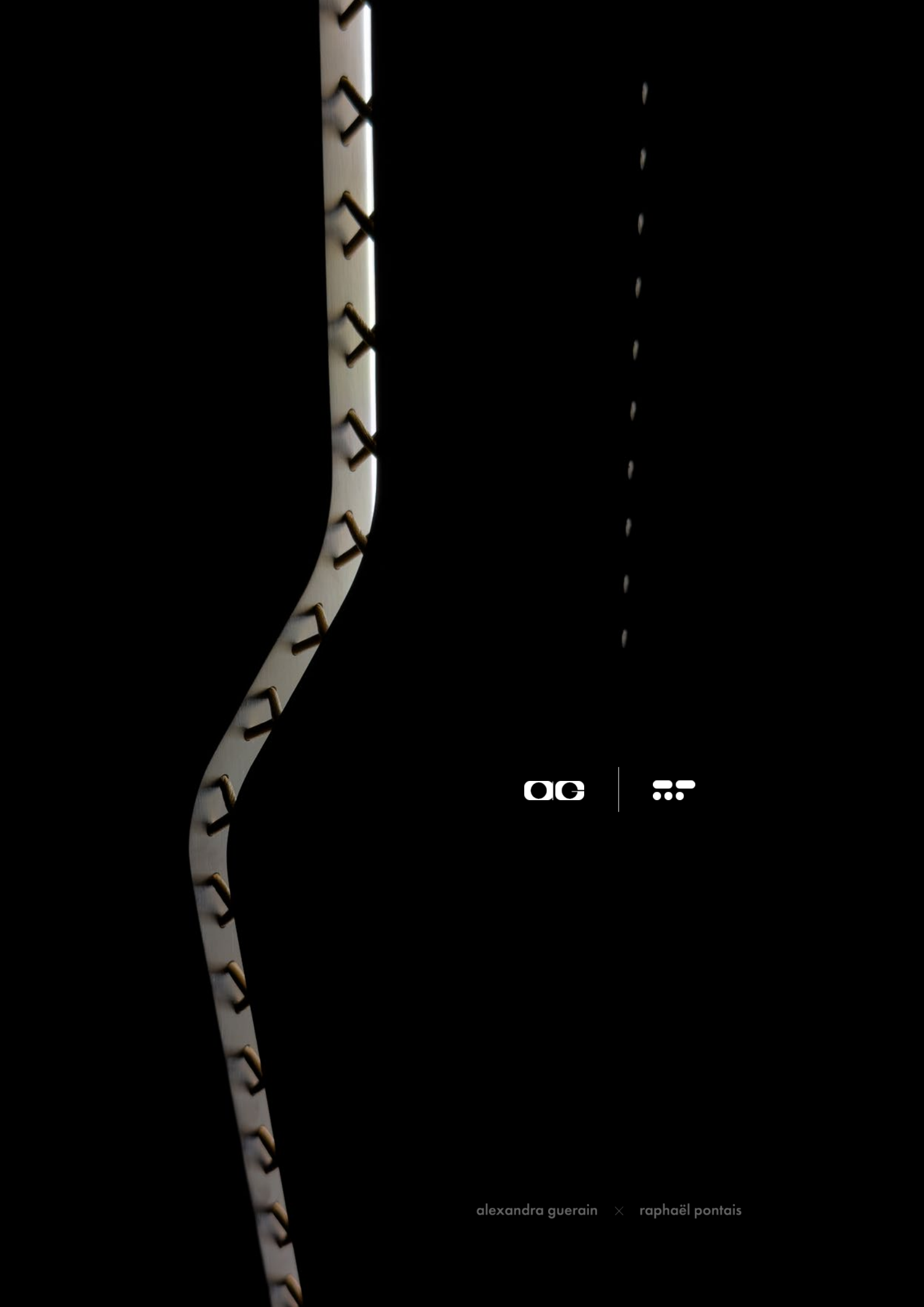

United by a shared creative affinity, Alexandra Guerain and Raphaël Pontais present a collaboration in which fashion and design converge into a common language. A collection defined by architectural lines, an industrial expression, and rooted in an urban aesthetic.

Represented in Paris by Galerie Anne Jacquemin Sablon and in New York by Delbert Arthur, Raphaël Pontais develops a design practice at the intersection of craftsmanship, industry and contemporary creation. His work has been presented in Milan, Eindhoven, at the International Design Festival at Villa Noailles, and in New York, notably at the Upper East Side residence of curator Ashlee Harrison. Following nearly two years working alongside designer Ora Ito, he now extends this approach into the world of fashion through the co-founding of the jewellery brand RS Founders Studio.

In parallel, Alexandra Guerain has taken the opposite path. After more than a decade in the fashion industry, she founded byalexandraguerain in 2024, bringing her perspective to the field of interior design. Shaped by her experience in fashion and an immersive engagement with residential architecture, she has developed an approach in which detail, proportion and materiality come together to form a distinctive design language.

The meeting of these two trajectories gives rise to a collection in which objects and accessories speak the same language. A body of work that affirms the natural continuity between design and fashion, united by a shared vision of creation.

This collection is the expression of an ongoing dialogue between the worlds of fashion and design, shaped by Alexandra Guerain and Raphaël Pontais.

Their practice has grown from a shared visual culture, informed by references that continue to guide their work: the sense of tension found in Alexander McQueen, Jean Prouvé's constructive logic, and the brutalist qualities present in certain contemporary fashion languages. More than influences, these references provide an intellectual framework that continually informs their creative process.

Crafted in stainless steel, their material of choice, the pieces articulate a language in which sculptural gesture and industrial construction exist in constant dialogue.

UNE ASSISE PAS COMME LES AUTRES !

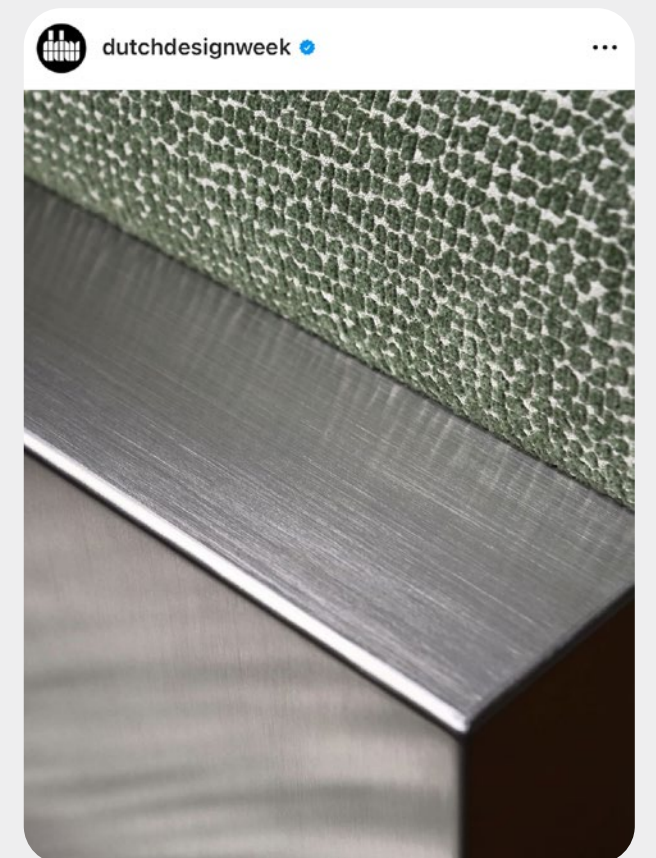
Avec son assise *Rooly*, le designer Raphaël Pontais réinvente le pouf. Ou comment élever un accessoire utilitaire au rang d'objet déco !

Designer pluridisciplinaire, Raphaël Pontais s'est spécialisé dans le mobilier et les objets d'intérieur. Après avoir fait ses armes aux côtés de l'architecte d'intérieur Oscar Lucien Ono, pour qui il a dessiné du mobilier destiné à des hôtels prestigieux et des résidences privées autour du monde, il nous offre une première création individuelle étonnante. Révélée lors de la Paris Design Week Factory, l'assise *Rooly* étonne par son jeu d'assemblage sculptural qui mêle la froideur du métal, matériau de prédilection du créateur, et la douceur d'un tissu chenille. Une harmonie d'ensemble tout en courbes qui invite à un moment de détente ! À moins qu'on ne trouve ce pouf si beau qu'on n'ose s'y asseoir... Nouvelle star de la scène déco, *Rooly* nous donne un avant-goût de la collection de mobilier dérivée de cette pièce *collectible* qui devrait bientôt voir le jour. On a déjà hâte...
